Redemonstrated are postsurgical changes in the right posterior parietal region again with thin linear elements of enhancing septation at the postsurgical site without discretely evident enhancing mass lesion. There may be slight interval progression of surrounding signal abnormality along the inferoanterior margin at the postsurgical site which again causes mass effect on the atrium and trigone of the right lateral ventricle and again to be considered would be nonenhancing but recurrent lesion at the postsurgical site. Continued follow-up as felt clinically appropriate.
